CAP Debt Centre Manager - Job Description

Role - Your role would be to set up and manage the running of the debt centre in partner ship with CAP and your church. You would support clients on their journey to becoming debt free, through home visits and ongoing support. All of this must be done in a way that positively reflects the Christian faith and the core values of the charity.

The minimum time commitment is 16 hours a week, comprising 4 consecutive hours, with at least 2 sessions being within normal working hours of 9am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

You must complete an application for an enhanced DBS disclosure, have access to the internet, have an active email address and you will need to have a car.
