**Hands of Compassion** is a charity started by Wendy Ray (formerly of Chalk Church) which founded the Hands of Compassion school in Chipulukusu, Zambia eighteen years ago. The school has been a big success and many children's lives have been transformed by the education they received there. Several people within Christ Church are active supporters of Wendy's work.

I have just received the latest newsletter from Wendy, written as she returns from her latest visit to Zambia. (A copy of the newsletter is on the board at the back of church by the Traidcraft stall). In it Wendy highlights the achievements of current pupils in the school but also tells us of two other schools which Hands of Compassion are supporting.

One is Jami Christian School, situated in a rural area about 20km from Ndola, which takes 73 children, some of whom walk at least 2km across the bush to get there. There is only one classroom and very limited resources and Hands of Compassion wants to raise £5,000 to build another classroom. The children have very little in the way of pencils so Wendy is asking for donations of small pencil cases containing just 3 pencils, 3 coloured pencils, a rubber and a pencil sharpener. She says "It is a small gift which will bring such pleasure to these children".

If you would like to help by donating a filled pencil case, there will be box at the back of church to put them in, I also have details of how you can make a monetary donation, if you would like to do so.
